Orchid of the Month: Neofinetia falcata

Neofinetia falcata, a famous native orchid of Japan, was the favorite of the ruling Shogun. Known as the wind orchid or the samurai orchid, it is one of the most beautiful and charming of all orchid species.

A compact growing vandaceous type that flowers freely in its summer season and often more than once a year will delight you with its elegant white blooms emitting a sweet coconut-like perfume. It grows easily in bark or moss in pots or

baskets along with cattleyas, phals or on a windowsill in the home or office. It can also be mounded in the traditional Japanese style. This is one adaptable orchid! In nature, plants can be dusted with snow in winter, and monsoons in summer. Its hybrids are just as desirable, and are sure to add color to the collection of this group.
