- Plant description; including full name, awards, and whether it is from a notable collection or grower
- Pot size (if potted), mounted or bare root
- One Jpeg photo of plant if possible in bloom
- General growing conditions (Warm, intermediate or cool growing? Blooming season?)

DONATED PLANTS SHOULD BE HEALTHY (no pests or diseases, please, though plants needing a little tlc are Okay. If you're unsure about a plant you want to donate, please bring it in a sealed, clear plastic bag and ask someone.

If you have growing supplies, books, journals or other orchid-related items you would like to donate, please get in touch with Mike.

To help people get into the buying mood, please bring a side dish or dessert! If you're able to arrive a little early to help set up tables and organize, that would be great. As in the past, we will be having a potluck. MOS will provide finger sandwiches, and as we do for our picnic and holiday party, please bring a finger food-type snack and drinks.







Hello!

My name is Lisa Roberts and I'm working with the show committee to help promote the World of Orchids show. We are working to increase your social media presence, specifically your Facebook page and we need your help!

If you are not already "following" the MOS Facebook page, please log into your account and visit the MOS page:https://www.facebook.com/massorchid/.

Below the main photo of the woman in the black hat, you will see a "like" button. Please click that. This means you "like" the page. Once clicked it should say "liked" and the hand should be blue. Then click on "following". This is now the important part, in the drop down menu (under "following") click on "see first". What this does is set a priority for MOS postings in your own feed and you will see these first when you open Facebook. I've circled in red below the area I'm speaking about.
